1. THE BLUEFIELD SHRINE HORSE SHOW IS NOT SANCTIONED BY USEF. However, every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rulebook will be conducted & judged in accordance therewith. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to submit entries that do not constitute a violation of these provisions.
2. The Secretary's office will open at 1:00 p.m. on THURSDAY AND FRIDAY, and 8:00 a.m. on Saturday. **ENTRIES WILL BE CLOSED THIRTY (30) MINUTES PRIOR TO EACH SESSION.** There will be **NO REFUND** of entry fees for any reasons except a veterinarian's letter. All entry blanks **MUST** be signed in both spaces provided and contains the complete and correct address of both owner and trainer. **OFFICE WILL CLOSE 30 MINUTES AFTER THE LAST CLASS ON SATURDAY NIGHT.** All point cards will be validated during office hours only.
3. **FEES:** The Horse Show will enforce an **OPEN CHECK POLICY.** Fees must be paid in full or an open check must be left in the office before back numbers will be released. Failure to settle an account by 6:00 p.m. Saturday, gives the Horse Show Secretary authority to fill in the correct amount owed to the Horse Show for all fees, stalls, entries, bedding, sponsorships, etc. Any check returned for non-payment will be charged a \$50. Handling fee and must be replaced by a certified check or money order. And THE USEF will be notified of any nonpayment.
4. **CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES:** To be eligible to compete in a championship class, horses must be entered, shown and judged in a qualifying class in its division.
5. **VAN, TRAILER, CAMPER AND AUTOMOBILE PARKING:** A designated area will be assigned for all vans, trailers, and campers to park after unloading of horses and equipment. There are 8 camper sites available at a flat fee of \$50.00 each for 4 nights or \$30.00 for a single day. There is only water & electricity hook up with gray water dump site, no showers. Camper sites must be called in & reserved with payment sent prior to horse show dates. You can call Wayne Barth to reserve a camper site at 1-304-320-7717. Campers not renting a camping site must be self-contained. All exhibitor automobiles will be parked in a designated area.
6. **EXHIBITORS SHOWING OFF OF TRAILERS:** There is a one-time \$20.00 fee (per trailer).
7. **COGGINS TEST:** All entries must be accompanied by a current negative Coggins certificate. Weanlings accompanied by Dams will use the Dam's Coggins, and weanlings unaccompanied by Dams must have their own negative Coggins test. If possible, please bring extra copies of your Coggins to leave with the show secretary.
8. **RESPONSIBILITY:** The Bluefield Shrine Horse Show, Beni Kedem Shrine, Charleston, WV, Shriners International, the Horse Show Management, ASHA of WV, and any member or employee of the Horse Show, shall in no way, jointly or individually, be responsible for a loss, accident, damage, or loss of life that may occur to any exhibitor, owner, trainer, agent, groom, stable, horse, corporation, partnership, individual, or spectator sustained while at the Bluefield Shrine Horse Show. All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damages incurred by their agents to other properties on the Show Grounds, and will be billed accordingly. Dogs will not be allowed on the grounds unless restrained by a leash and under control of the owner or responsible person at all times. No dogs will be allowed in the show ring area.
9. **ATTENDANTS:** All attendants entering the ring must be properly attired.
10. **HOLDS:** Holds will be limited to **five minutes** and will only be for rider conflict in back to back classes. The rider's name and back number must be filled out on a hold card and left at the secretary's office before the show begins.
11. **MANAGEMENT:** The show shall be under the absolute control of the management. Only qualified persons shall be allowed in the ring during judging. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judge or Officials on the part of the owner, rider or groom will disqualify horse or rider and all fees will be forfeited. Inappropriate sportsmanship behavior will not be tolerated by the show committee.
12. **WARM-UP RING:** Due to the small size of the warm-up area, we are asking that you come to the warm-up area no more than two classes prior to your scheduled class. Please be courteous to the riders/drivers going in the current class ahead of you. No hooking horses or ponies in the warm-up ring.

THE HORSE SHOW COMMITTEE RESERVED THE RIGHT TO:

1. Vary or add to the names of those officials who have been invited to participate.
2. If two (2) or less entries second and third place money will be awarded.
3. Cancel or combine any class as deemed necessary, postpone the show for any cause found advisable. Refuse any or all entries, return any money paid for stalls or entry fees without explanation or recourse to the show for liability or compensation, or to eject from the grounds any exhibitor or horse should the best interest of the show be served. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of the Management. **No added classes.**

THE CONSESSION STAND WILL BE OPEN SATURDAY MORNING, JULY 23, 2016

SATURDAY MORNING SHOW – RULES

Juvenile classes are for children 17 and under unless * otherwise noted. Beginner rider classes are judged on general horsemanship skills. Academy riders may ride/show in all Saturday Morning classes (age appropriate).

All classes are for horse or ponies unless specified. Proper attire is required. Jackets are optional in all classes EXCEPT ACADEMY- NO JACKETS.

All Walk and Trot classes are for riders having never shown in a class requiring a canter at this show (exception are the Go As You Please classes).

ACADEMY RULES

Riders in this division are students who are taking riding lessons and are to be judged on their riding skills. Riding suits and derbies are not allowed; Jodhpur boots and pants are suggested and PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR is REQUIRED. Academy riders MAY NOT enter in any other division at the show (Thursday night, Friday night or Saturday night classes). A rider who has shown in a regular division class requiring a full riding suit and derby at any show is prohibited from participating further in the academy division. Horses that are used are to be LESSON HORSES. HORSES MUST BE FLAT/KEG SHOD. These horses MAY CROSS – ENTER into ASB Country pleasure division at this show with a rider that is not in the Academy division. Horses are not to be judged. Horses may be shown in a snaffle bridle (martingales are allowed); Pelham or full bridles and flat cutback English type saddles. Hoof blackening and braiding are prohibited. Class splits will be made when there are more than 12 entries in a class. There will be minimum holds allowed, please be prepared to enter the ring when the class is called, there will be a 2 minute gate call per class. This division is open to all breeds of horses.

ACADEMY SHOWMANSHIP

The RIDER is judged on the horsemanship and ringmanship. (The ability of the rider to handle the mount and put it through its required gaits correctly). The horse is NOT to be judged. Promptness in finding correct diagonals and leads are important as well as the rider's command of the horse (speed, placement in the ring, and collectiveness).

Academy and Showmanship entry fees are \$10 per class. PLEASE TRY TO MAKE YOUR ENTRIES ON FRIDAY AND THEN MAKE CORECTIONS ON SATURDAY.

_____, Exhibitor, shall indemnify and save harmless Bluefield Shrine Horse Show, Beni Kedem Shriners, their employees, officers, directors, agent and members; Imperial Council A.A.O.N.M.S., an Iowa Corporation; Shriners Hospital for Children, a Colorado Corporation; and all their affiliated corporations and each of them (collectively "The Shrine") from any and all claims, demands, liabilities, losses, damages, penalties, fines, costs and expenses (including reasonable attorneys fees and expenses) of every character whatsoever arising from or connected with, the exhibiting of a horse or horses in the BLUEFIELD SHRINE HORSE SHOW ("Show") and all activities related thereto, from and expenses incurred with respect to the leasing of space and the showing of a horse or horses by the exhibitor. To the extent valid and enforceable under applicable law, the aforesaid obligation to defend, indemnity and save harmless shall include, without limitation, claims, demands, liabilities, losses, damages, penalties, fines, costs and expenses by and resulting from the negligence of the exhibitor and the participation of the horse or horses which are being entered in the Show.

UNDER WEST VIRGINIA LAW, ANY EQUINE ACTIVITY SPONSOR OR EQUINE PROFESSIONAL IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN EQUINE ACTIVITY RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISK OF ACTIVITIES.

Equine activities include inherent risks of which you should be aware! They are as follows:

- (A) The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death, or loss to persons on or around the equine;
- (B) The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals;
- (C) Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions;
- (D) A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object;
- (E) The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an animal or failing to act within the ability of the participant

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Bluefield Shrine Horse Show, hereafter referred to as "Competition" and I have been made aware of these inherent risks and agree that "show management or their agents" shall not be responsible for any accident or injuries to the horses or persons involved!

I AGREE to release the competition and the Bluefield Shrine Horse Show and the Bluefield City Park from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the harm resulted directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of harm to me or my horse, including harm resulting from the negligence of the competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred) the competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any harm caused by me or my horse at the competition.

I AGREE that "competition" as used above includes all officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.

I REPRESENT that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

Upon these conditions, I enter the horse listed on the face of this document.

SOUTHEASTERN HACKNEY ASSOCIATION-- Incentive Program

The SEHA will contribute funds that will award additional prize money to owners or exhibitors showing ponies at selected horse shows in member states.

One horse show in 6 member states will be selected. The member states that have the most members are Georgia, Tennessee, North Carolina, South Carolina, Virginia and West Virginia. Other states that are included in the SEHA region are Alabama, Florida, Mississippi and Louisiana.

The SEHA will contribute \$1050 to each horse show to award additional prize money to the top 3 ponies whose OWNER and EXHIBITOR are SEHA members. Amateurs and professionals are eligible to earn money. There is an annual fee to nominate the ponies to the program. It is \$50.

There will be \$150 awarded per championship class for Road Pony, Amateur Road Pony, Harness Pony, Hackney Pony, Jr. Exhibitor Road Pony, Road Pony Under Saddle and Pleasure Driving Pony. If the show does not offer a championship class in that division then the money will be awarded in the class that is held (for example Junior Exhibitor Road Ponies may show in an Amateur/Juvenile Championship) and if that happens then they would not receive additional money in the Championship.

The Owner of the pony AND the Exhibitor of the pony MUST be members of SEHA in good standing with their membership paid either before or on the date of the competition with the postmark of the membership being what determines the date of eligibility. The owner OR the trainer must be a resident of one of our member states. No one will be allowed to join after the competition and receive money. If the owner and exhibitor are the same person, only one membership fee is to be paid.

The SEHA members will vote on which shows will be adding the incentive money.

The recommended shows are:

Georgia: The Dixie Cup Horse Show
